ABOUT

Lights Valley wines commemorate Colonel William Light and his discovery and naming of Barossa Valley in 1837. Barossa Valley was named in memory of the British victory over the French in the Battle of Barrosa in 1811. However, due to clerical error the valley was misspelt Barossa.

With each bottle, Lights Valley not only offers a taste of the Barossa Valley's terrior but also honours the legacy of a man whose contributions helped shape the region's history.

TASTING NOTES

The Surveyor General Shiraz offers generous flavours of black fruit, chocolate and hazelnut. Fine tannins provide impressive depth of palate.

VITICULTURE

Sourced from a low yielding single vineyard in the central north-west region of the Barossa Valley, where warm dry conditions and rich red soil provide the backbone to some of the region's best-known wines.

WINEMAKING

Small batch ferment, hand harvested, 15 days skin contact.

Pressed to American oak hogsheads, 12 months maturation, single barrel selection, blended, additional 12 months oak maturation.
